A Reason to Embrace Easter

Her name is Immaculee Ilibagiza. She was born in Rwanda, the tiny country in central Africa that most of the world knows about for one reason: the 1994 genocide in which more than a million innocent people were viciously slaughtered in the cruelest ways imaginable.

While Rwanda is roughly the size of Maryland, it has a population of more than eight million, making it one of the most densely populated countries in the world. It is also one of the poorest. Immaculee's rural village had a one-room school house and no running water or electricity.

Yet, when the massacre hit her village, Immaculee's father, Leonard whispered a word of prayer and told her go to a Hutu. Pastor Murinzi agreed to hide eight Tutsis in a small bathroom of four feet by three feet, and they were squeezed together so tightly that they could hardly breathe.

Mary, the mother of our Lord could hardly believe the news that Jesus was arrested. So Mary just remembered!

Mary remembered how a voice from Heaven proclaimed in a blessing, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you." (Luke 1:28)

Mary remembered when Jesus said, "Why are you searching for me?" He asked, "Did you know I had been in my Father's house?" (Luke 2:49)

Mary remembered after Lazarus' death, Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies, and whoever lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25)

Yet Immaculee lived in a tiny four feet by three feet space for 91 days fearing for life only survival genocide with grace and mercy written into the DNA of her soul.

After the French troops arrived in western Rwanda to set up safe zones, Pastor Murinzi smuggled eight woman to a nearby camp on a moonless night, and they spent weeks in relative safety, eating real food for first time since the genocide.

Perhaps, the hardest moment for Immaculee was when she learned that most of her family had died at the hands of Hutu mad men. It was after the tears came running down her face that Immaculee remembered Jesus' words from the Cross, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."
